| Discussion | A motion to approve minutes from the October Brain Injury Trust Fund Board meeting was made by board member Jason. Board member Latoya seconded the motion. Board members Dawn and Jenn abstained. All members voted in favor and the motion was carried. | | |

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4. Program Update/Mission and Vision

Discussion

- There were no oppositions to the proposed Vision and Mission statements that were sent out to the board via email. Board member Dawn moved to approve the Vision and Mission statements. Board member Victoria seconded the motion. All members voted in favor and motion was carried.
- Judy announced that Liz Gerdeman is the new Director for MINDSOURCE Brain Injury Network.
 Judy will join the February Trust Fund Board meeting to formally introduce Liz who has about 10 years of experience in brain injury working with the Brain Injury Alliance of Colorado (BIAC) and brings a great depth of knowledge of the initiatives and various projects that MINDSOURCE is engaged in.
- Judy announced that board member Danny is term limited and his term ends June 2020. Judy will
 send out information that can be provided to anyone interested in joining the Trust Fund Board along
 with guidance on steps to take to apply. The board discussed considering another physician,
 geographic diversity and ethnic diversity.
- MINDSOURCE will begin to write the Request for Proposal (RFP) during summer 2020. Prior to the RFP being released, the board will need to decide whether or not it is feasible to expand the definition of who is served to include those with non-traumatic and traumatic brain injury per the legislation that was signed into law in May, 2019. Judy connected with Gregory Tung at the Colorado School of Public Health to partner with residents in the preventative medicine residency program. This project will determine what the prevalence of non-traumatic brain injury is as it is defined in the statute, determine the methodology to predict those with non-traumatic brain injuries who would seek out support and determine the fiscal impact. The goal to have the analysis completed is set for May 2020.
- Judy provided an update on House Bill 19-1147 that BIAC ran last session and the \$450,000 state
 general funds that were to be provided to MINDSOURCE on going. Due to a mistake in drafting of
 the fiscal note, the funds were drafted as a one-year appropriation. Should an amendment that
 Jennifer Mello and BIAC are pursuing not be approved, MINDSOURCE will discuss a budget request
 through the Department.
- MINDSOURCE met with the accounting department that communicated there is an increase in revenue based on the new surcharge amounts.

5. Work Group Reports

Discussion

- Board member Angie reported on the Vision and Outreach Committee. Thomas presented to the BrainSTEPS community team leaders on the community grants. The committee is awaiting research data in order to determine the goals for the upcoming competition. The target completion timeframe for grant awards is April 2020.
- Karen reported that the research and program evaluation committee will focus efforts on the RFPs for
 Client Services and Research in 2020. An outside evaluator will look at client services along with
 feedback from the board to produce a report to include a logic model that MINDSOURCE will utilize
 when writing the client services RFP. The committee will review the Kone study and the Colorado
 Brain Injury State Plan in order to develop priorities for the research RFP. Lastly, the committee is
 looking to add language into the RFP on the expectations around products from research grants. The
 goal is to reach out to current grantees at the one-year mark to obtain products and highlight that
 work on the MINDSOURCE website.
- Jennie reported that during the last Strategic Partnerships meeting, the committee reviewed the strategic plan and began to identify partners and point of contacts. The committee is scheduled to have a meeting on Thursday, Dec. 19th.
